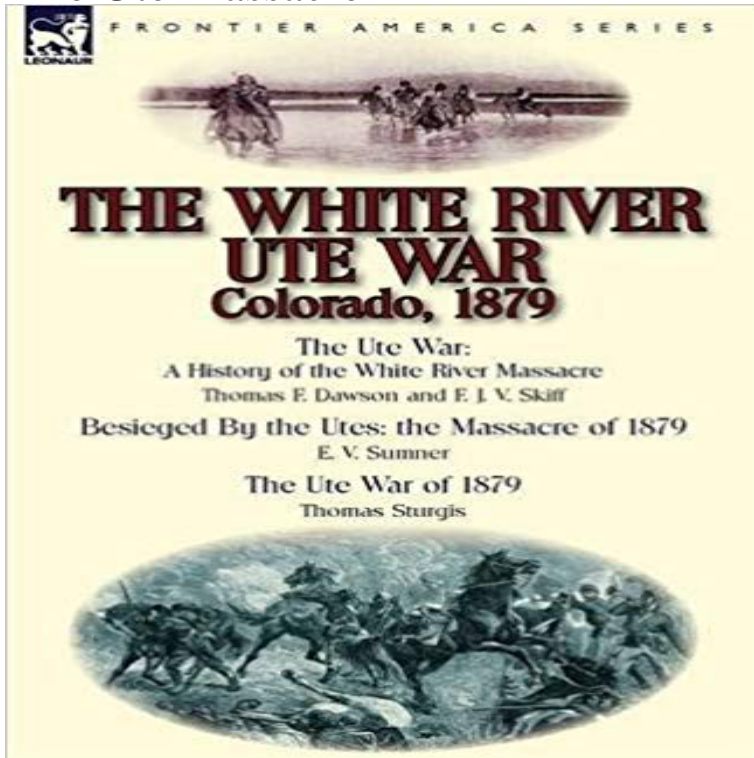

Meeker was appointed as Indian agent for the Utes on the White Ute warriors also attacked the Indian agency, killing 11 men. Hungry natives rallied around a young Ute firebrand, Black Hawk, who had been provoked into killing five Mormons, then escaped with hundreds of cattle.
